I look forward to having a good month full of fun and growing our membership.

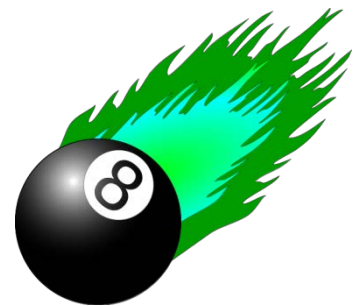

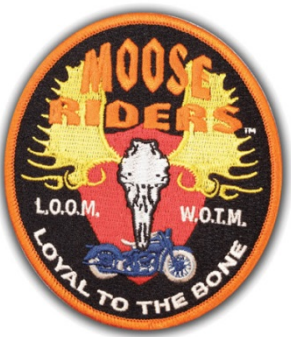
