## LEON COUNTY EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

On Tuesday, June 23, 2020, the Leon County Board of County Commissioners called a special meeting to discuss requiring citizens to wear face covering. In the end, Leon County approved an emergency ordinance requiring face covering scheduled to begin Thursday, June 25 at 12:01 AM. The ordinance states that an individual in a business establishment in Leon County must wear a face covering while in that establishment.

For purposes of this ordinance, a business establishment means a location with a roof overhead which any business is conducted, goods are made or stored or processed or where services are rendered. Also, for purposes of this ordinance, the term "business establishment" also includes locations where non-profit, governmental, churches and quasi-governmental entities facilitate public interactions and conduct business.

There is a list of exemptions where facial covering are not required to be worn. One of these exemptions is "**Restaurant and bar patrons eating or drinking**". What this means to our members is that if you are in our Social Quarters eating or drinking, you do not have to wear a face covering. If you are in our Lodge building for any other reason, you must wear a face covering.
