On Tuesday, September 5, 1882, around 10,000 workers marched from Union Square to City Hall. The Knights of Labor passed a resolution to hold each subsequent holiday on the first Monday of September. Thus, Labor Day was born.

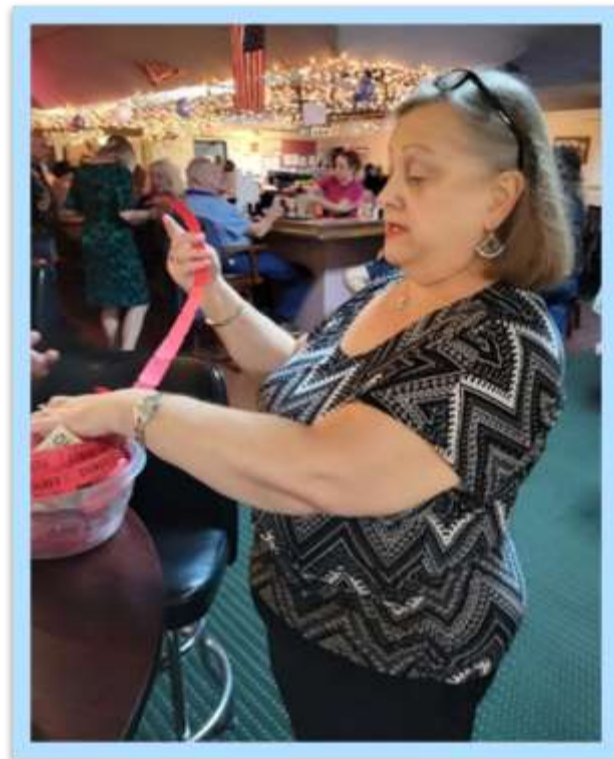

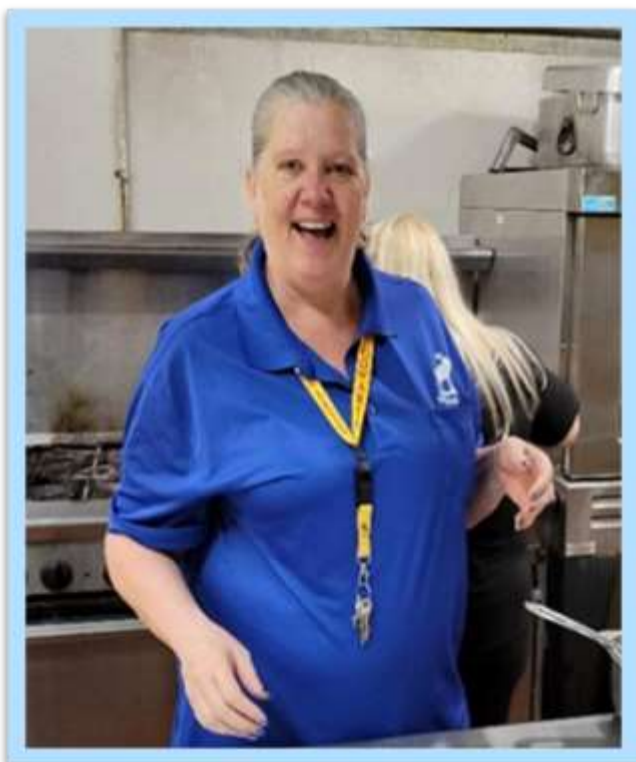

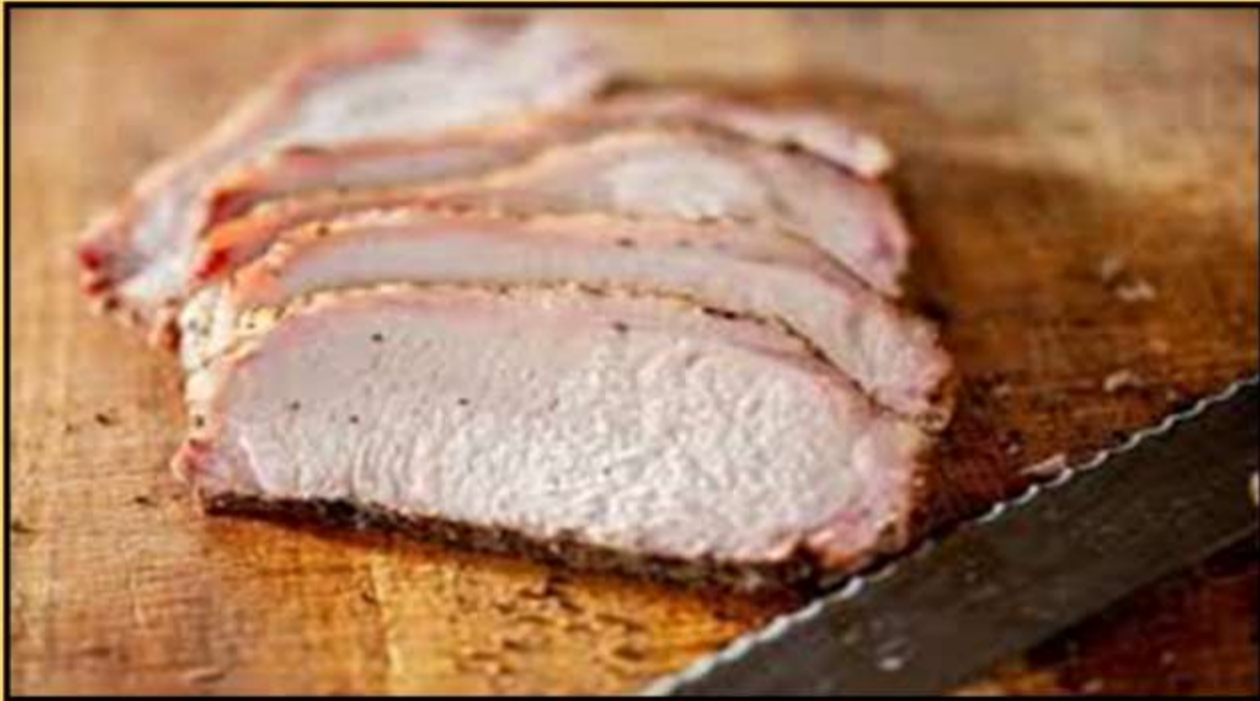
