IMPORTANT NOTICE

MOOSE LODGE 1075 2022 Officer Elections & Schedule

Any current Lodge member interested in or who has decided to run for a Lodge Officer position for the new Fiscal Year Term (May 1, 2022 – April 30, 2023) needs to read the eligibility requirements and time schedule below which must be adhered to per Moose International By-Laws.

Elective Officers – The elective officers of our Lodge shall consist of a President, Vice President, Chaplain, Administrator, Treasurer, and three (3) Trustees who must be active members of the Lodge in which they are elected. All officers, except the Administrator and Trustees, shall serve for one (1) year. The Trustees shall be elected to a three (3) year term, providing their terms are so arranged that one (1) expires annually. No officers shall be eligible to serve more than two (2) consecutive terms in any one office, unless the Chief Compliance Officer issues a dispensation. Each officer shall serve until their successor is elected and installed.

Eligibility of Officers - Only active Moose Lodge 1075 members, who are also either active members of one of the men's higher degrees or a Women of the Moose unit (or establish such active membership within sixty (60) days following installation), may be considered for any elected office. Eligibility requirements for Lodge officers are as follows:

President – Been an active member of the Lodge for at least six (6) months immediately preceding the date of the election **and** completed at least one (1) year in another elected office (not a combination of offices) of the Lodge in which they seek office. (This means that that no prior Women of the Moose (WOTM) member will be able to run for President this Fiscal Year beginning 05/01/2022 because it would have been impossible for them to meet the requirement “completed at least one (1) year in another elected office (not a combination of offices) *of the Lodge* in which they seek office.” The word “Lodge” means Lodge 1075 and would not encompass the WOTM Chapter 1103. Also, take note that any WOTM member who will be considering running for President for the Fiscal Year beginning 05/01/2023, you will have to complete a 1-year term in another elected office of the **Lodge** this Fiscal Year beginning 05/01/2022.)

Vice President – Been an active member of the Lodge for at least (6) months immediately preceding the date of election.

Chaplain - Been an active member of the Lodge for at least (6) months immediately preceding the date of election.

Treasurer – Must be an active member of the Lodge.

Trustee - Must be an active member of the Lodge.

Exceptions from these qualifications require a special dispensation from the Chief Compliance Officer. A special dispensation will only be granted in exceptional circumstances.

Any Lodge member who desires to run for a Moose Lodge 1075 Officer Position must complete a form stating your desire to run and the Officer Position you are running for. These forms may be picked up from the Administrator, Richard Williamson. After completing and signing the form, the form must be turned in to the Administrator no later than March 08, 2022 @ 5:00 PM. Each candidate who submits his name for Office, must be interviewed by the Nominating Committee.

2022 Schedule of Elections

February 01 – Announce formation of Nominating Committee with the 1st Meeting of the committee to be held on February 15 following the Business/Membership Meeting.

February 15 – Nominating Committee Meeting to follow the Business/Membership Meeting.

March 01 - Nominating Committee Meeting to follow the Business/Membership Meeting.
March 08 – Last date @ 5:00 PM to submit name to run for Office.

If any additional names are submitted after the March 01 Nominating Committee Meeting and up to March 08 @ 5:00 PM, an additional Nominating Committee Meeting will be called to interview and consider whether or not to add these candidates to the Ballot.

March 15 – Report of the Nominating Committee will be given at the Business/Membership Meeting.

April 05 – Elections will be held at the Business/Membership Meeting starting at 7:00 PM. Elections will be the 1st order of business.
