Special Election
Moose One Tallahassee Lodge 1075 Board of Officers
2 Trustee Board of Officer Positions

Originally the LOOM Board of Officers included 3 Trustee Positions. A few years ago, as it got harder and harder for Lodges to fill a full Board of Elected Officers (9 positions total), Moose International agreed to let Lodges apply for dispensation to allow them to operate their Board of Officers with only 1 Trustee. A couple of years ago the Tallahassee Lodge went to the 1 Trustee Board format due to their inability to seat a full board with 3 Trustees.

Beginning May 1, 2021, the men and women joined forces to become Moose One which basically doubled our Lodge Membership to approximately 900 members. Due to this increase in membership, Moose International has suggested that we attempt to add two more Trustees to our Board of Elected Officers to get us back to a 3 Trustee Board. As Moose One, any qualified man or woman member of Tallahassee Moose Lodge 1075 can now run for any open position on our Board of Officers.

Being that said, we are hereby announcing that we now have open for election 2 Trustee Board of Officer Positions. One of these positions is a 2-year Trustee Position and the other is a 3-year Trustee Position. This basically means that you are obligating yourself to serve on the Board for a term of either 2 years or 3 years as a Trustee. Again, any qualified man and woman member of the Tallahassee Moose One Lodge may run for either of these 2 elected positions. Any qualified member who desires to run for either of these 2 Trustee Board of Officer Position must get a Form from Administrator Richard Williamson to complete stating the Position they desire to run for and sign the form. All forms must be completed, signed and returned to the Administrator by Friday, July 16, 2021.

If we have any candidate(s) sign up to run for the office of Trustee, here is a tentative Election date schedule after the deadline (Friday, July 16, 2021) to turn in a form to run for a Trustee Officer Position:

Tuesday, July 20, 2021 – Nominating Committee Meeting. All candidates for office are required to meet with the Nominating Committee to be interviewed.

Tuesday, July 27, 2021 – Nominating Committee Meeting (only if necessary).

Tuesday, August 3, 2021 – Report of the Nominating Committee will be read at our Business/Membership Meeting.

Tuesday, August 17, 2021 – Elections. These will take place during our Business/Membership Meeting.

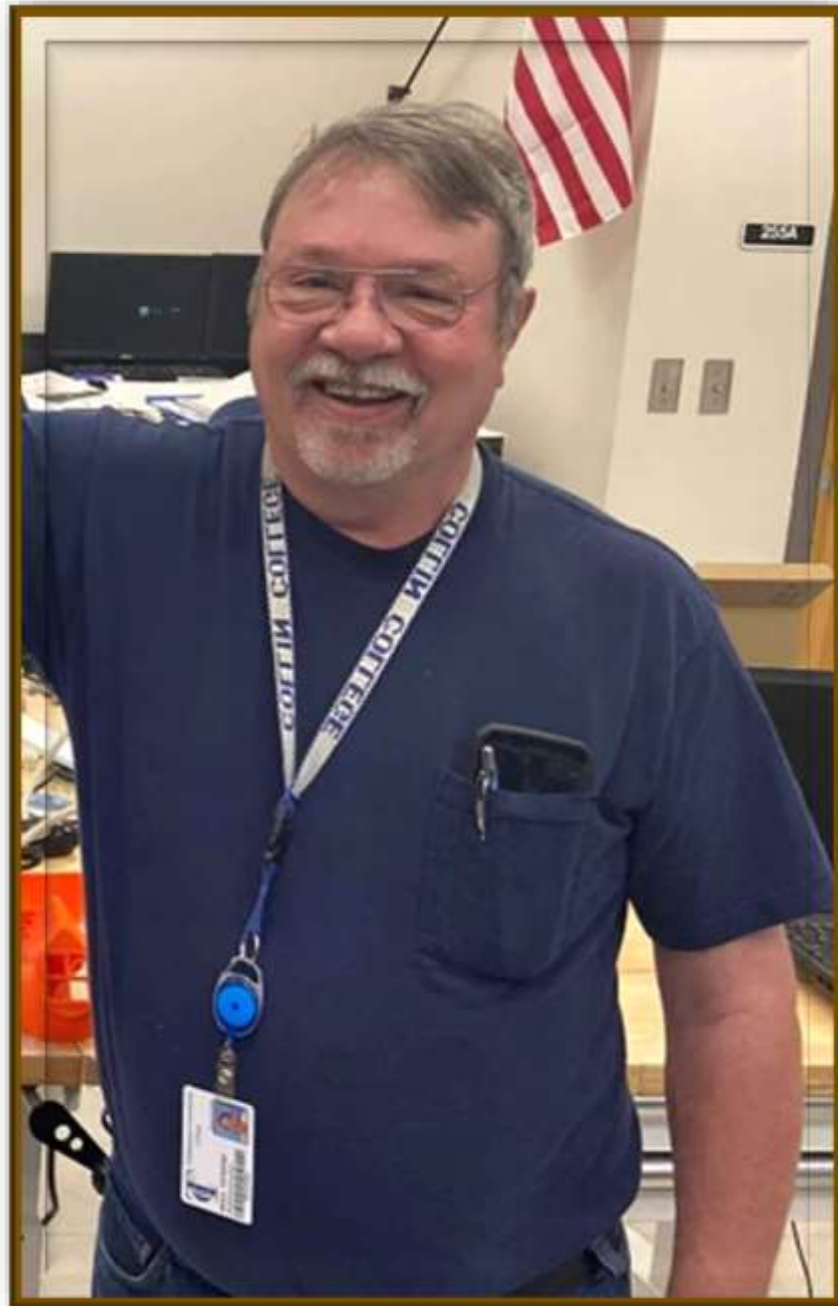
