- We are always looking for suggestions for Wednesday night meals.






The Lodge won 2nd Place at the Road Runners Chili Cook off. Way to go Carl and Brian.

I had never met him, but my friend had known him for decades. After a short conversation, the old man reached into his pocket and gave us each a four-leafed clover encased in a protective sleeve. His face was radiant with joy as he passed along this emblematic good luck charm. Seeing his enduring smile, all I could think of was how much happiness he got from making others feel special. He was alive with love. He radiated it.

I love the word “radiant.” It’s one of the words E.B. White’s Charlotte weaves into her web to save a pig’s life. It’s a word rich with love and joy and insight and wonder.
