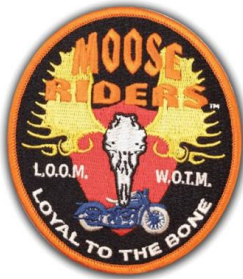

March and April are busy months here at our lodge , lots going on be sure to read your monthly calendar!

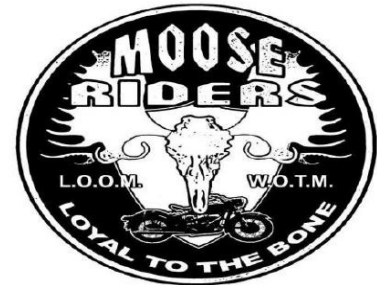
