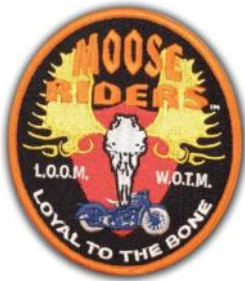

Moose Riders have several things in the works so please stay tuned.

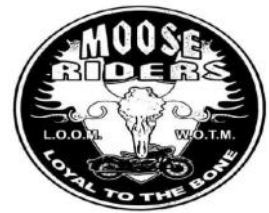
Chili Cook Off will be Jan 20, 2018. I know it's early but as fast as the months seem to be flying by, it will be here before you know it!

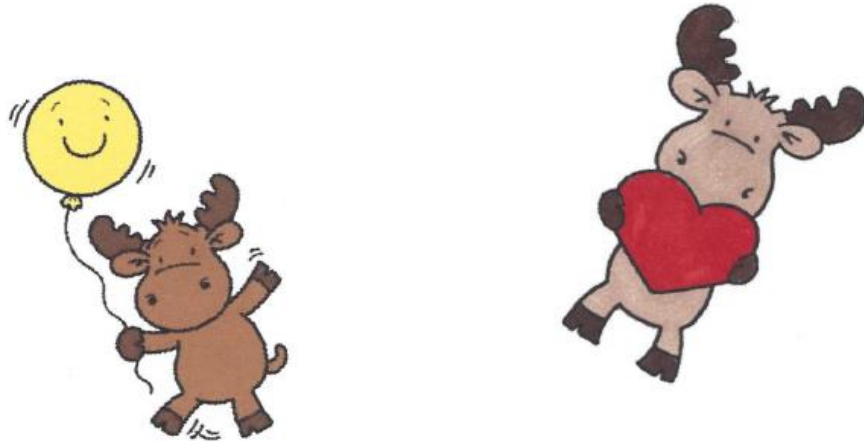
