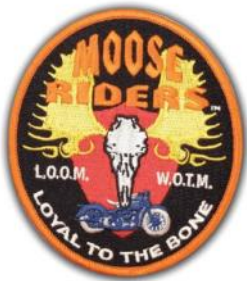

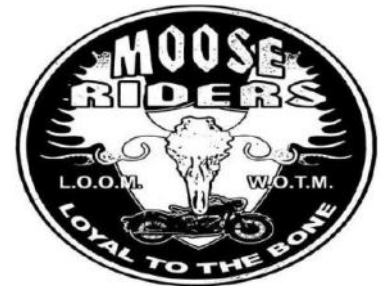

This is what our Lodge and Moose Lodges everywhere do.

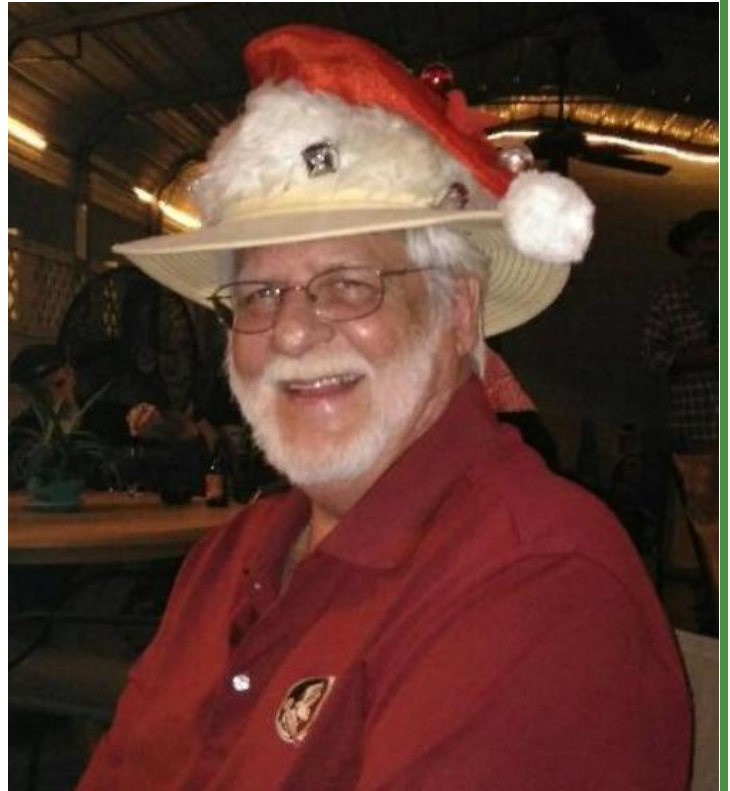
