
All applications need to be turned into Jamie, our recorder by 2 pm on Sunday 23, 2017. Apr 24th will be the last time that we will be able to vote on new members.



Elections will be held on April 4, 2017 to elect a new slate of LOOM Board of Officers which will take over May 1, 2017, the beginning of the new Moose Fiscal Year.

Offices up for election will be Governor, Jr. Governor, Treasurer, Prelate and 3 Year Trustee.

The Elections will take place during the Business/Membership Meeting which starts at 7:00 PM. Anyone who desires to run for an Officer Position must fill out and sign a form ASAP stating which Officer position they desire to run for. These forms can be picked up from our Administrator, Richard Williamson.
