

LOOM Election Notice

Elections will be held on April 4, 2017 to elect a new slate of LOOM Board of Officers which will take over May 1, 2017, the beginning of the new Moose Fiscal Year.

Offices up for election will be Governor, Jr. Governor, Treasurer, Prelate and 3 Year Trustee.

The Elections will take place during the Business/Membership Meeting which starts at 7:00 PM. Anyone who desires to run for an Officer Position must fill out and sign a form ASAP stating which Officer position they desire to run for. These forms can be picked up from our Administrator, Richard Williamson.

The Nominating Committee will be interviewing candidates on Tuesday February 21st after the Business/Membership Meeting and on Tuesday March 07th after the Business/Membership Meeting.

March 14th is the absolute deadline to sign up to run for an Officer.

If any additional names are submitted after the March 07 Nominating Committee Meeting and up to March 14, an additional meeting will be called to interview and consider whether or not to add a candidate to the Ballot.

At the Business/Membership Meeting on March 21st, the Report of the Nominating Committee will be given stating which candidates for each Officer position have been approved by the Nominating Committee and will be placed on the Elections Ballot.

Again, Elections will be held Tuesday April 4th during the Business/Membership Meeting which starts at 7:00 PM.




