## **MOOSE RIDERS**

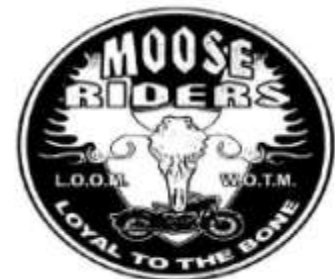
A big “Thank You” to everyone who came out in support of our donation presentation to Triple R Horse Rescue on May 30th. Your support is greatly appreciated!

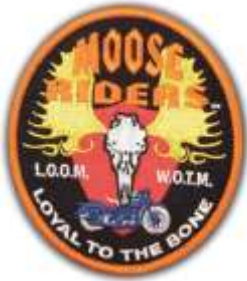
