The 2022 FMA Annual Conference was held in Orlando September 8 – 11

Our Lodge was recognized as Top Donor for 2020-2021.

Catherine Mingledorff attended as our WOTM delegate. She attended many sessions and said she learned a lot about the Moose Organization and what the WOTM contribute. Here are just a few of the things from her report.



WOTM are financial providers of Mooseheart and give over two million dollars annually from our 114 forms.

- We provide for physical and occupational therapy, Christmas gifts and celebrations, New Child Right Start kits, Boys and Girls Athletic Programs, the auditorium and Music department.
- Our Scholarship and Maintenance fund has donated \$1,961,770 in the last five years. In the last two years all Mooseheart graduates qualified for scholarships.
- WOTM dues generate \$1,400,00 each year.

WOTM are the financial providers for Moosehaven and provide:

- Pharmacy assistance to offset prescriptions not covered by Medicaid or Medicare.
- Vision, hearing and dental needs.
- Christmas parties, decorations and gifts.
- Beauty and Barber shops.
- Daily needs: deodorant, toothpaste, socks, sneakers, etc.
- Assistance on the sea wall and pier (repair and rebuild).
- Katherine Smith Hall is fully funded by chapters for those who suffer from dementia or Alzheimer's disease.

In 2021-2022 we provided Community Service that raised over 15 million dollars to Community endeavors, all this while a pandemic was still going on.

One thing that was mentioned many times was that Florida is on top. We were commended for our work and enthusiasm by Shawn Baile, the Director of Moose Legion.

- Our mission has remained the same for the past 108 years. Our objective is to gather in close fraternal relationships and to assist in the charitable activities of our Moose Fraternity, with special attention to Mooseheart and Moosehaven.


